## Pack Dues and Medical Forms

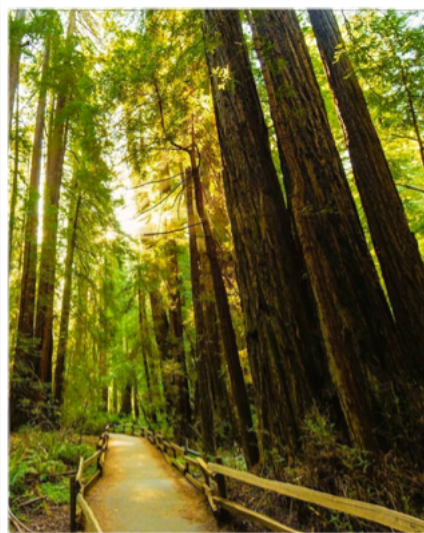
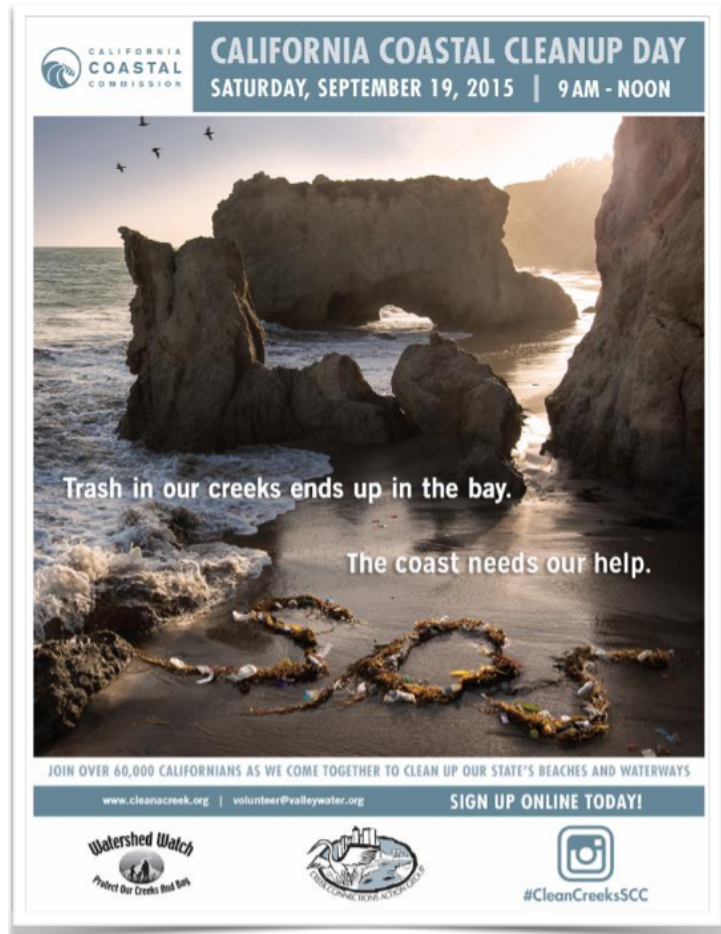
